

## Pozo Cacahuatate (SR6)

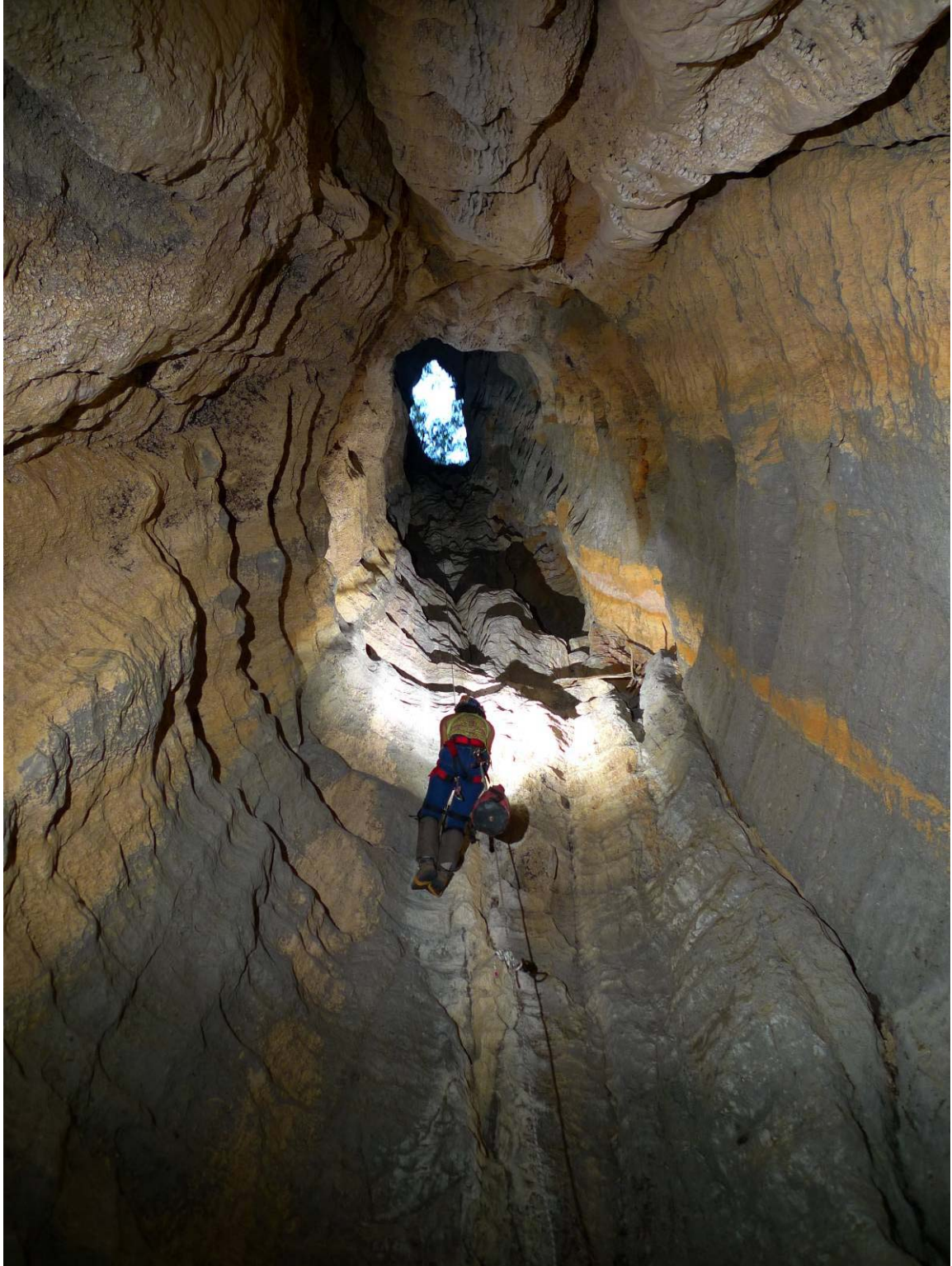
Depth: 70 m

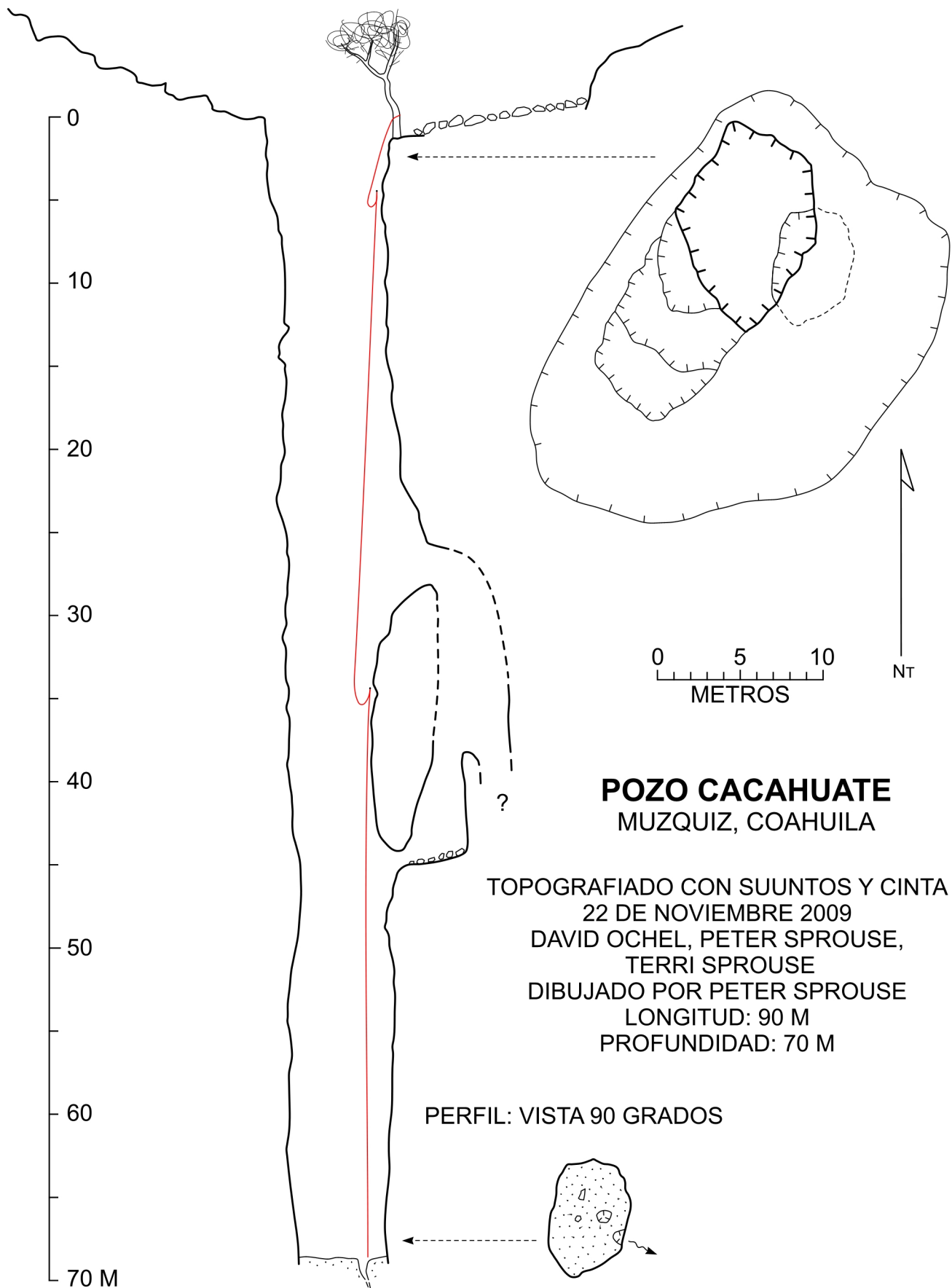
This pit is located in the middle of a very large sinkhole. It was located by Geoff Hoese and Peter Sprouse in October 2009. Peter mapped it on 22 November 2009 along with David Ochel and Terri Sprouse. They were able to rig from a convenient cedar tree that hung over the rim. Two rebelays got them to the bottom, which had a small drain in a dirt floor. On the way out Terri spotted an incoming side passage, which Peter then swung into. By rigging a deviation so as not to lose the rope he was able to get off rope and explore it. It opened into a dome up which daylight could be seen, apparently it connects back into the main shaft. However, it also appeared to break over into a parallel pit going down, which should be checked.
