

Pozo Gatita (PS20)

Depth: 37 m

This pit has a small entrance in an exposed bedrock area on the side of a valley to the north of Sótano Foxy Hole. It was discovered by Sandi Calhoun, Rodolfo Maltos, Peter Sprouse, and Taco Van Ieperin. Sandi and Peter were joined by Susan Souby in exploring the pit on 28 November 2009. The pit is slightly off vertical, and two rebelayes were set in it. Close to the bottom is an infeaser dome that contributes water and flowstone. The bottom has a wet dirt floor with active flowstone and soda straw formations.



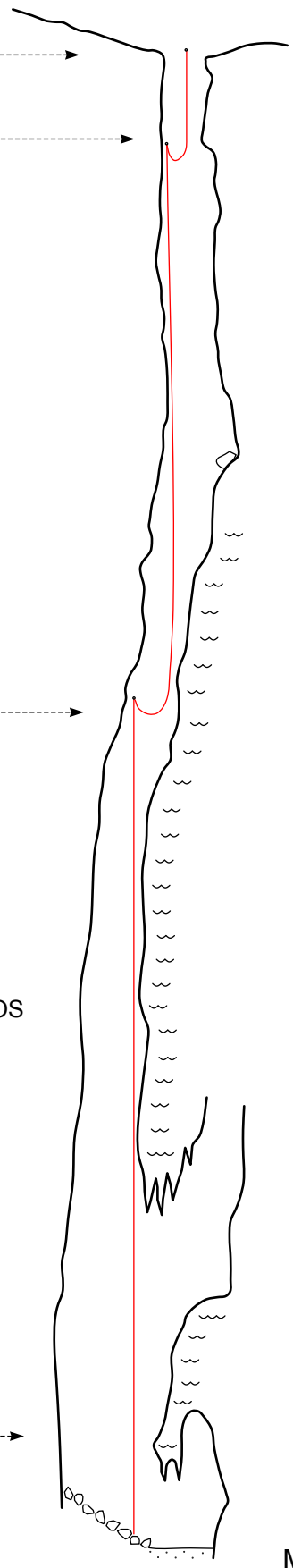
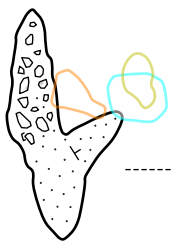
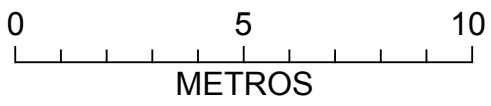
