

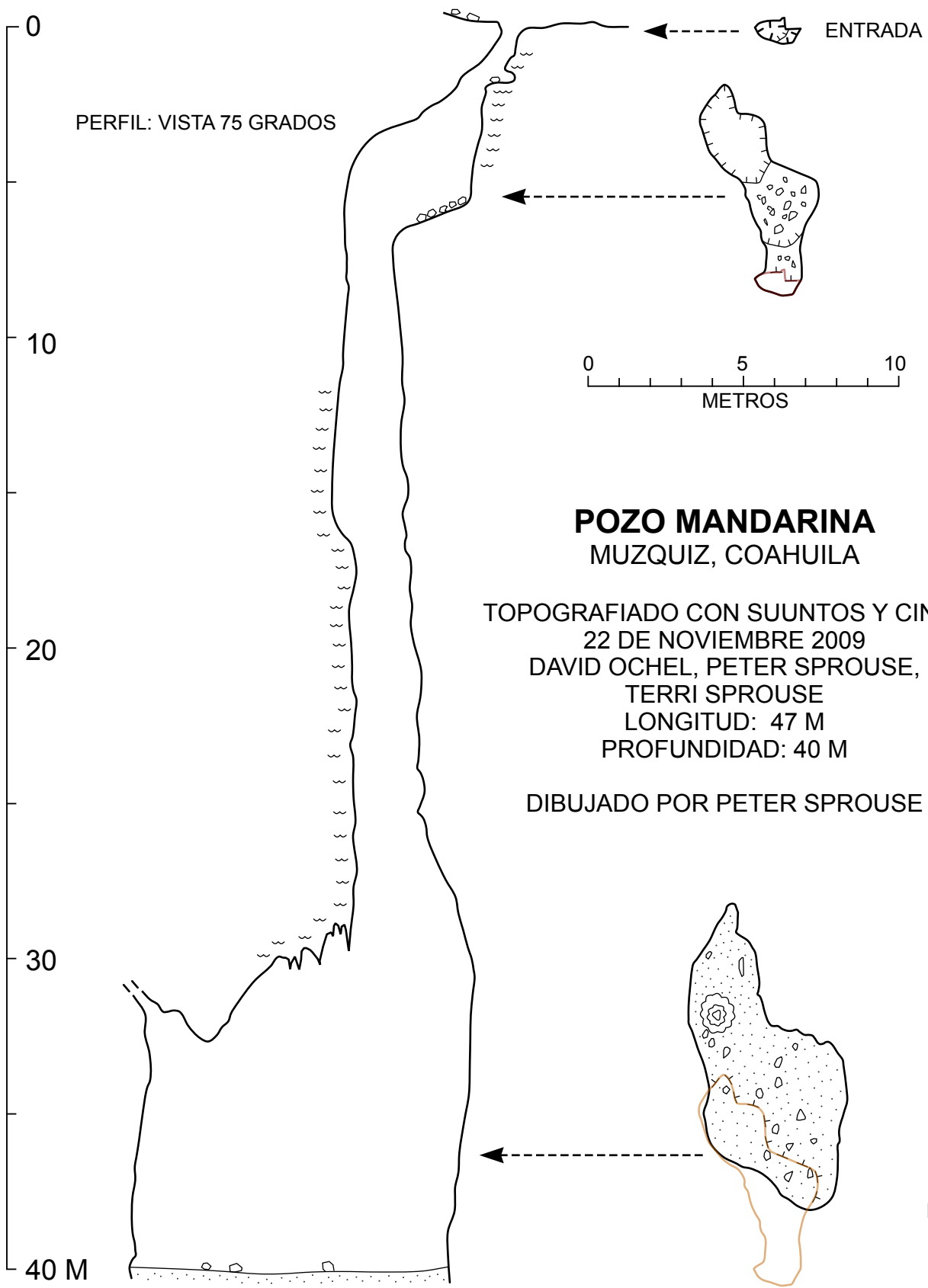
Pozo Mandarina (SR5)

Depth 40 m

This pit is located at a bend in the road that comes from Rancho San Rafael. The entrance is a few meters in diameter and can be rigged off of a live oak tree. The entrance drops 6 m to a sloping ledge covered with loose rocks. A 33 m shaft follows to a dirt-plugged floor. Geoff Hoese, Rodolfo Maltos, and Peter Sprouse discovered this pit in October 2009. Peter mapped it on 22 November 2009 with David Ochel and Terri Sprouse.
