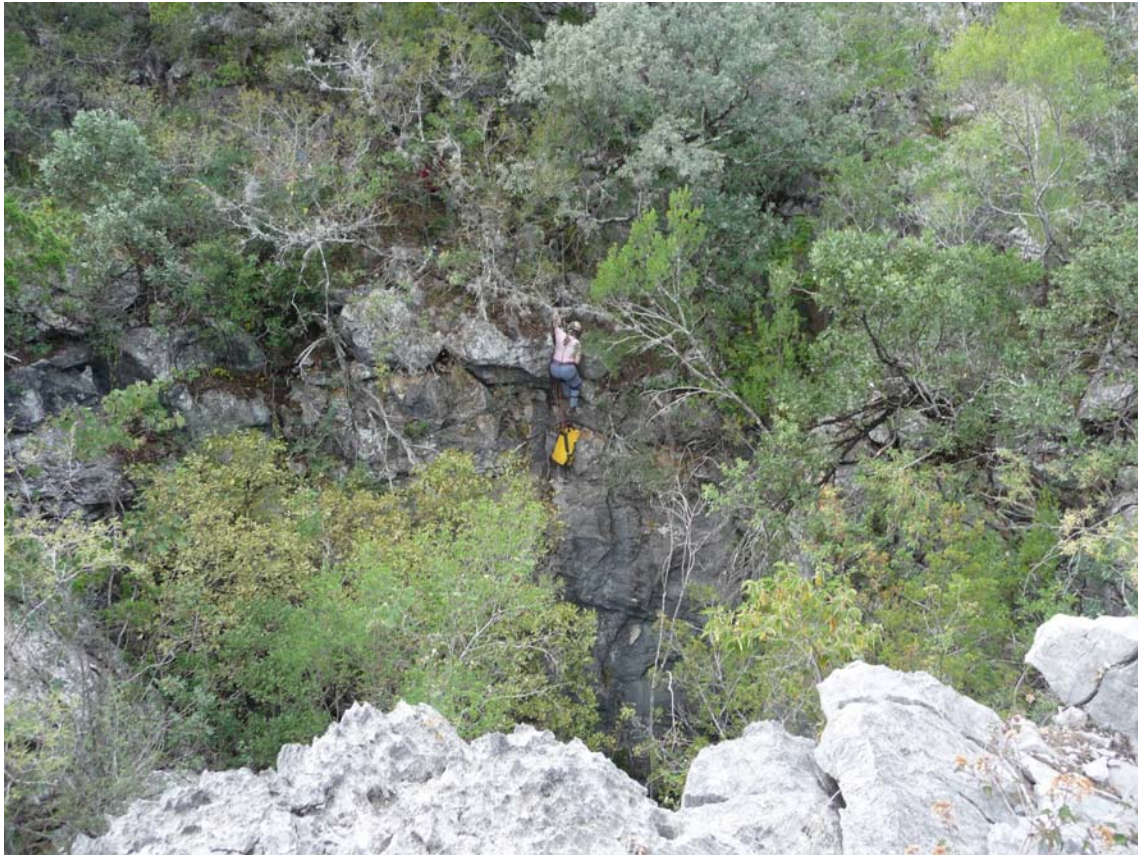


Pozo del Tecolote Occidental (SR9)

Depth: 151 m

This is a 151 meter deep open air pit with daylight to the bottom. It is located in a dolina approximately 25 meters across. The shaft averages 10 m in diameter and drops down the middle of the doline. Two snakes were seen in the pit, a corn snake in an alcove just off the floor, and a garter snake crawling up the wall about 2/3 of the way down. About halfway down on a small ledge was a wide-eyed screech owl observing the rigging process. A small owl skull was found on the bottom.
